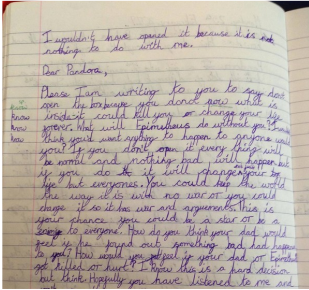

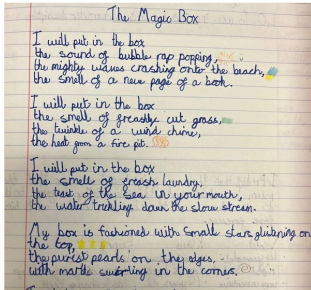


Fabulous pop art from Emily. She researched carefully, grasped the concept well and executed her self portrait beautifully.

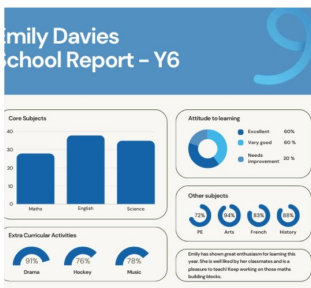

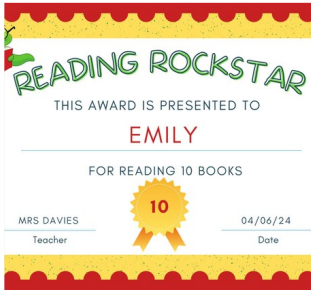
Comments:
